Byelaws made by the Council of Teignbridge under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 for the good rule and government of the District of Teignbridge and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances

INTERPRETATION

1. In these byelaws:

"designated area" means any area named in the Schedule to these byelaws.

SKATEBOARDING

2. No person shall skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances in a designated area.

PENALTY

3. Any person offending against byelaw 2 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
