TEIGNBRIDGE DISTRICT COUNCIL

BYELAWS made by the Council of Teignbridge under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 for the good rule and government of the District of Teignbridge and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

EXTENT

- (1) Byelaw 3 applies throughout the District of Teignbridge, but not to any designated area.
- (2) Byelaw 4 applies to all designated areas.

INTERPRETATION

In these byelaws:

"carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a highway, being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles;

"designated area" means any area named in the Schedule to these byelaws;

"footway" means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only;

"highway" means the whole or a part of a highway other than a ferry or waterway

SKATEBOARDING

No person shall on any footway or carriageway skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances in such a manner as to cause danger or nuisance or give reasonable grounds for annoyance to other persons lawfully using the footway or carriageway

No person shall skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances in a designated area.

PENALTY

Any person offending against byelaw 3 or 4 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.

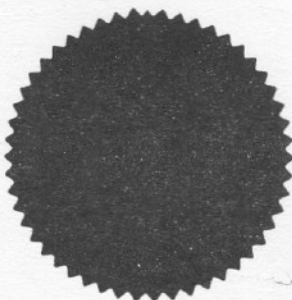
