



STREET TRADING

TEIGNMOUTH LICENCE STREET

Applications are determined by the Service Lead - Legal and Democratic Services in consultation with the Licensing Officer.

Grounds for refusal of applications are:-

- a. That there is not enough space in the street for the applicant to engage in the trading in which he desires to engage without causing undue interference or inconvenience to persons using the street;
- b. That there are already enough traders trading in the street from shops or otherwise in the goods in which the applicant desires to trade;
- c. That the applicant desires to trade on fewer days than the minimum number specified in a resolution;
- d. That the applicant is suitable to hold the licence by reason of having been convicted on an offence of for any other reason;
- e. That the applicant has at any time been granted a street trading licence by the council and has persistently refused or neglected to pay fees due to them for it or charges due to them for services rendered by them to him in his capacity as licence holder;
- f. That the applicant has without reasonable excuse failed to avail himself to a reasonable extent of a previous street trading licence.

A fee of £212 for 12 months and is not refundable if the application is refused.

Hours Permitted to operate:

During the period 1st October to 30th April (on Friday and Saturdays only) until Midnight
During the period 1st May to 30th September (on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturdays) until 12.30am
