

# Park rules for the season 2015 at Kennford International Caravan Park

## **Barbecues:**

- **Barbecues are permitted as long as they stand off the ground** and do not present any hazard to others. Please ask the office staff where you can safely light a barbecue and respect your neighbours and the Park facilities when having a barbecue.

## **Dogs:**

- **Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times on the park and estate areas.**
- **Dog owners must remove their dogs fouling from the park, recreation field and ensure that their dogs do not create undue noise and disturbance.**

In the interest of all, there is a zero tolerance policy on the two matters above and failure to comply will be considered as a breach of the contract.

## **Bicycles:**

- Details of local rides are available with tourist brochures in the back room of the toilet block
- The Highway Code must be observed at all times whilst riding a bicycle on the Park, especially on the main road into the Park, over the speed bumps and where trees may obscure visibility. For their own safety, we would ask cyclists to wear a helmet.

## **Children:**

- Please escort young children to the toilets and showers for those of you in non-serviced caravans.
  - Please make sure that ball games are only played in the areas specified and away from other guests and their vehicles. A designated games area is located near the reception.
  - Kite flying is not permitted on the Park due to the potential danger of overhead cables.
  - In order to prevent injury, NO tree climbing is allowed on the park.

## **Environment:**

- **Motor cars:** must not exceed the speed limit of 10 mph and must be driven in a careful manner **by licensed and insured drivers** within the Park — repeated speeding will be considered as a breach of contract. Your Car should be parked only in designated parking areas or on the outside door side of your holiday unit (one car only). They must not inconvenience other guests.
- Any Additional vehicles will be charged at £2.00 per vehicle per day.
- Please respect the "no access signs" and the privacy of the residential areas. .
- No radio transmitter or similar items will be allowed on the Park

**Fire points and Alarms.** Please make sure that you know where these are sited on the Park.

## **Incident Book:**

Whilst the Park Owners accept no responsibility for accidents or theft caused to any person during their stay at the Park, any such incident should be brought to the Owners attention, who will give assistance when required.

## **Pitch:**

**Grass** is cut as near to the Holiday caravans as practicable. It is the Caravan owner's responsibility to keep the area immediately adjacent to and under the Holiday Caravan cut and tidy. A compost heap is provided next to the garage for any garden rubbish - do not dump anywhere else. Written permission should be sought from the owner prior to siting of flower **pots and paving stones** adjacent to any holiday caravan - no flowers to be planted directly in the ground.

**Gazebos, tents and other additional exterior items** such as a boat, trailers etc., are only allowed under special circumstances. Their siting has to be approved by the owners **and will be chargeable.**

Each *static* holiday caravan is to have a **maximum of one non -combustible shed**. This is to be of an approved size and type to comply with the latest fire regulations.

For the convenience of all guests, it is requested that the caravan owner treat only the *immediate* area adjacent to the outside door of his/her holiday caravan as his/her space.

**Trees and shrubs;** under no circumstance should any tree or shrub or its branches be removed nor any tree or shrub be planted without prior written authorization from the Park owner.

**Spare Key to caravan:** The Park office should be in possession of a key to each caravan. Please check.

## **Security:**

For security reasons, please advise the Park Office when family or close friends are visiting or using the Caravan in your absence.

## **Washing**

Washing lines are permitted as long as they are removed after use.

Please note that toilets and showers are not available for fully serviced caravan owners.

- The hot water supplies in the Toilet blocks are for personal washing use only. Please do not attach hose pipes to any of the water stand pipes or taps on the Park.

## **Waste:**

- Please keep the Park tidy by disposing of rubbish in the dustbin compounds provided. Should you wish to dispose of larger items please contact us who will organize removal. All wastewater to be emptied down wastewater points **ONLY** not at the fresh water taps. No soak ways are allowed directly into the ground. Empty chemical toilets, greasy water, etc. into the receptacle provided in front of the main toilet block, which is clearly signposted.
