THE DISTRICT OF TEIGNBRIDGE (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2019
NOTICE OF MAKING

NOTICE is hereby given that Teignbridge District Council has made an Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 to amend and revoke the District of Teignbridge (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2018 and all previous Orders.

The effect of the Order is: -

- (a) To vary and increase the charges. Where the charges have been varied the previous charge is shown at columns 6a and 7a.
- (b) To change the designation in the following car parks
 - Gales Hill car park, Teignmouth – to include Teignmouth permit holders.
 - Quay Road – to extend the use of the Shopmobility Bays from 3.00 pm to 4.00 pm – Monday to Friday.

To make other minor amendments to the 2018 Order and to incorporate the charges and conditions contained in the Schedule below.

The Off-Street Parking Places to which the Order relates are set out in the Schedule below.

The Order as made can be examined at the Council Offices, Forde House, Newton Abbot, Devon between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday. The Order can also be viewed on the Council's website at www.teignbridge.gov.uk.

The Order will come into force on 8th April 2019. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it, or they, are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any of the requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
